

Milestones Preschool: 2015-2016 Program & Tuition Schedule

Milestones tuition rates are based on a 180-day academic school year. Any summer tuition or extra-curricular activities will be in addition to these rates. Milestones does not offer tuition credits for vacation, illness or other missed school days. Families are responsible for the specific program's annual tuition. Payments may be made in 9 1/2 monthly or 19 bi-monthly installments over the school year. Families enrolling after the start of the school year may have their tuition pro-rated based on time of enrollment. Milestones charges a one-time preschool registration fee per child at the time of enrollment. Monthly rates are shown here and maybe calculated for annual, semester or bi-monthly payments.

Milestones offers programs for One Year Olds – Pre-Kindergarten (KPrep) children. Preschool age children are enrolled in programs based on age and date of birth and for some by meeting a developmental milestone (i.e. walking, potty trained). Milestones enrolls children in a program that they will be in for the entire school year. Children are not moved on or near their birthdays.

Preschool Hours of Operation

Milestones Preschool opens at 6:30 a.m. and closes at 6:00 p.m. The preschool follows the charter school's academic calendar. The preschool will be closed on days that the charter school is closed. Please review the school calendar for details.

Half Day Programs

Milestones offers morning and afternoon half-day programs. Morning programs are offered from 8:30 a.m. – 12 noon and afternoon programs are offered from 1:00 – 3:30 p.m. All half-day children requiring care beyond their schedule time will be charged \$6 per hour, in 30-minute or \$3 increments. Regularly utilized extended care may require permanent enrollment into a full-day program.

Tuition Discounts

Milestones' offers 10% off preschool tuition for families with more than one child paying a monthly, academic tuition (Ones – KPrep). The discount is given to the youngest child. No discounts given to K-8th Grade Extended Day charges.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

Milestones requires a one-month's notice for withdrawal for all tuition paid programs. This notice may come in the form of 30 days notice, one month's tuition or a combination of the two. Refunds will be given to families that have remitted tuition beyond the 30-day notice. No refunds will be given for registration or cultural arts fees paid. Families may receive copies of their child's school records after all financial obligations have been met.

Extended Leave Absence

Milestones, within reason, will work with families of preschool students that require an extended leave of absence. An extended leave requires a minimum of two full weeks of consecutive absences. Parents should communicate with both the classroom teacher and office personnel regarding specific dates and make-up work. Those that have a child enrolled in a tuition paid preschool program may hold their child's spot by paying for 50% of their monthly tuition. This may be done for no more than two months per school year. Families that are absent for more than two months per school year will be required to either pay the entire monthly tuition or will lose their child's spot.

Payment Methods

Milestones accepts cash, check or credit payments for all tuition charges and school fees

Snacks & Lunch

Milestones will provide snack to all preschool students. Parents are required to provide non-refrigerated lunches for their children. While microwaves are available, please send lunches that take no more than 90 seconds to warm. Teachers will not cook or make "easy-mac" or ramen noodles. Milestones will provide 1% milk or apple juice for lunch if needed.

Registration Fee - \$100.00- One-time fee for children with continuous enrollment in preschool programs.

Ones

1:6 ratio, children are required to be 12 months old at the time of enrollment, walking, drinking from a “sippy cup”, and able start self-feeding.

Through caring teachers, our toddlers are able to explore, discover and learn about themselves and their environment. Activities that introduce music & movement, arts & crafts and both independent and social play allow toddlers to development their motor, cognitive, social and emotional skills.

One year old program schedules are flexible based on parents choice and school availability.

Twos

1:8 ratio, children required to be two by October 15, 2015.

Growing vocabularies, expressing feelings and the introduction of colors, shapes, letters and numbers are focused on in our two-year old room. In addition to fine and gross motor development, two year old self-help skills, like potty-training, hygiene and dressing, are supported by our teachers. Story time, music & movement and group play allow for cognitive and social growth.

Two year olds full day program schedules are flexible based on parents choice and school availability. Two year old half day program schedules are set and cannot be altered.

Threes

1:13 ratio, children are required to be completely potty trained. No diapers or pull-ups. Children required to be three by October 15, 2015.

Teachers will help our three year olds make discoveries for themselves both academically and socially.

Becoming a responsible member of the classroom community, feeling confident to take risks with activities and projects will allow for independence. Through circle time, books, table work and a print-rich environment supports preliteracy skills, as does math and science skills with sorting, patterning and counting.

Three year olds full day program schedules are flexible based on parents choice and school availability. Three year old half day program schedules are set and cannot be altered.

KPrep (Fours)

1:15 ratio, children required to be four by October 15, 2013. Uniforms Required.

The KPrep program is structured around a phonics based curriculum. This program offers teacher & child directed, challenging activities in the various subject areas of literacy, math, science and social studies. Circle time/calendar, table work, fine & gross motor and hand's on activities are utilized in preparing our students for their school age years. Age appropriate expectations allows for an environment of respect and safety.
